Workshop Objectives:

Participants will...

...consider topics that involve reaching students; including culturally responsive teaching, joy in learning, being an energized educator, and brain science for deeper learning.

...consider topics that involve empowering educators; including moving beyond grades, rewards, and testing, trying new things, leveling-up your teaching and being awesome.

...consider topics that involve improving schools; including systematic inequality, leadership, accountability, and what should be at the heart of every school

...define specific goals and action plans to implement changes that positively reach students, empower educators, and improve schools.
