The Teachers on Fire podcast profiles agents of growth and transformation in K-12 education. Host Tim Cavey chats with inspiring educators to bring you their highs and lows, passions and goals, and the voices and influences that are shaping their thinking and inspiring their practice. Cavey is an 8th grade educator and vice-principal in Vancouver, BC, Canada. He has completed a Master's of Educational Leadership degree through Vancouver Island University, and the 2020-2021 school year was his 20th in education. In this 3-part podcast exploration, you will learn to Ignite the Flame, Avoid the Burnout, and Spark the Fire as it pertains to your own passion for teaching and learning.

## Workshop Objectives:

Participants will...

...try out three methods designed to improve concentration and evaluate comprehension when listening to podcasts; including, SketchNotes, MindMaps, and One-Pagers.

...ignite their flame in one or more of these areas: agency, innovation, creativity, productivity, edtech

...avoid burnout by strengthening their passion, engagement, creativity as they listen to the inspiring stories of three educational disruptors.

...spark their fire by changing mindsets: moving from the judge-and-be-judged mindset to the learn-and-help-learn mindset; moving from a mindset of surviving to a mindset of thriving, and moving from the negativity surrounding the Covid experience to positivity

...define specific goals and action plans to implement changes that positively impact student learning, teaching practices and school communities.
