**Workshop Description:**

*Teachers on Fire*, hosted by Tim Cavey, is a weekly podcast designed to inspire, empower, and equip K–12 educators. Each episode delivers heartfelt stories, fresh perspectives, and practical strategies to elevate your teaching practice. Guests include innovative teachers, leaders, and changemakers who share insights on topics like instructional coaching, educational leadership, classroom innovation, and more. The show also tackles pressing challenges such as teacher burnout, student engagement, and tech integration—offering actionable advice you can use right away.

**Workshop Objectives** (What should participants know or be able to do upon completion of this workshop?)

Participants will...

- \*Define ways to lead from their current position and to create, grow, and collaborate.
- \*Identify growth moments and formulate next steps.
- \*Utilize the 5 S's, 4 A's, and 3 M's of teacher wellness to design their own self-care program.
- \*Learn new assessment strategies that improve both the student and the teacher experience.
- \*Complete a final exam including questions designed to assess understanding of the selected podcast episodes and to prompt thoughtful reflection. The short answer questions ask participants to articulate professional and personal goals related to each episode and outline specific, actionable steps to achieve them.
- \*Experience three methods designed to improve concentration and evaluate comprehension when listening to podcasts; including, SketchNotes, MindMaps, and One-Pagers.
