Workshop Description:

The Educational Duct Tape Podcast focuses on viewing educational technology as a tool used to meet goals, address learning standards, and solve problems in the classroom, much as duct tape is used as a tool that solves a plethora of problems in our lives. Each episode features a different inspiring educator helping the host, Jake Miller, answer teacher questions with awesome ideas for using tech in the classroom.

This course is divided into 3 parts. In *Focus I: Engage*, educators will learn how to use the TPACK and SAMR frameworks and sites like Voxer, EduMatch, and GridPals to connect with other educators as they plan engaging lessons for their students. In *Focus II: Influence*, educators will discuss culturally responsive practices and insights from brain research. Leveraging choice and agency to hear from all students will also be explored. In *Focus III: Create*, educators will learn ways to help students make the jump from being content consumers to being content creators. Applications such as Canva, Buncee, Book Creator, and Wakelet will be discussed. Assessment through video and digital portfolios will also be examined.

Workshop Objectives (What should participants know or be able to do upon completion of this workshop?)

Participants will...

- ...try out three methods designed to improve concentration and evaluate comprehension when listening to podcasts; including, SketchNotes, MindMaps, and One-Pagers.
- ...be able to engage their students in meaningful EdTech experiences designed with the TPACK and SAMR frameworks
- ...be able to connect with other educators using platforms such as Voxer, EduMatch, and GridPals.
- ...learn culturally responsive practices.
- ...discuss brain research insights.
- ...be able to employ student choice and agency to make sure all students have a voice.
- ...be able to guide their students in the world of content creation using sites and apps such as Cava, Buncee, Book Creator, and Wakelet.
- ...learn to assess students both formatively and summatively using video and portfolios.
