Brian Mendler is committed to changing lives one teacher and student at a time. This course will dive more deeply into 9 episodes from The Brian Mendler Show podcast which focus on understanding student behavior, inspiring teacher excellence, and transforming school culture.

Brian Mendler Biography: "Plagued by severe undiagnosed ADHD and reading difficulties, I began disrupting class in 4th grade. I believed my peers would laugh at me for being "dumb" so I made sure they laughed at me for being "bad" instead. I was defiant, disruptive, relatively unmotivated. By sixth grade my academic skills were so below grade level that I was pulled / kicked out of school. During my senior year, I started gambling. The next five years were a cycle of lying, cheating and stealing to feed my addiction. In 2001 I entered recovery. I am now clean 17 years. Today I am a certified teacher, presenter, and international key note speaker. I have co/authored six books, including the best seller, That One Kid, Tips for Teachers, Power Struggles, Tuning Tough Parents into Strong Partners, and my newest book, Watch Your Mouth."

Workshop Objectives:

Participants will...

...try out three methods designed to improve concentration and evaluate comprehension when listening to podcasts; including, SketchNotes, MindMaps, and One-Pagers.

...work to understand student behavior, including the importance of modeling as compared to punishing, teaching students to persevere and to overcome, as well as other components for success when working with underperforming students.

...consider topics that inspire teacher excellence, including the two most powerful words and the four most unhelpful words, becoming a champion for all and putting teachers first.

...consider topics that transform school culture such as developing an innovator's mindset and looking for the good.

...define specific goals and action plans to implement changes that positively impact student learning, teaching practices and school communities.
